Elections in India are considered as the biggest event when all the adult citizens celebrate democracy by casting their vote.

India's lower house of parliament, the Lok Sabha, has 543 elected seats. Any party or coalition needs a minimum of 272 MPs to form a majority government.

Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs) are used at all polling stations. The entire process is strictly monitored by the Election Commission of India.

Being the citizens of India, one should be aware of the most important Fundamental Right – “**Right to Vote**” and the process by which Government of India is elected. Let us perform some of the tasks given below and become aware about the functioning of the biggest democracy of the world.

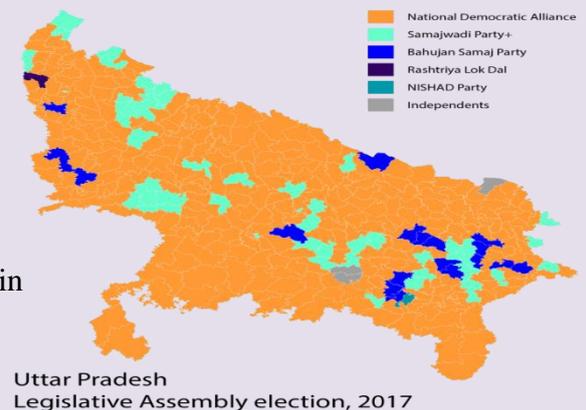

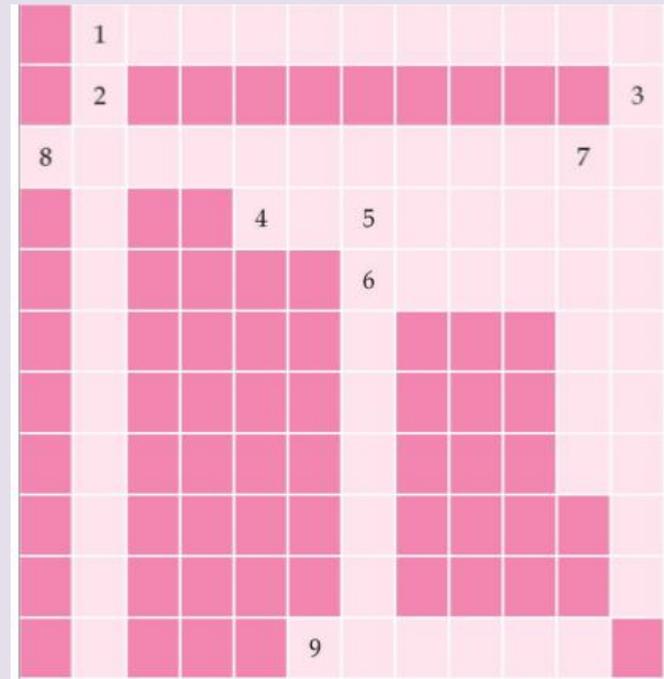
I. Think & Solve the Triangle crossword puzzle

3. VEDIC MATH:

Welcome to the wonderful world of “Vedic” Mathematics, a science that helps us to calculate faster and easily, making the fear of Math a thing of the past! Let’s research on “Vedic” Mathematics and sharpen our brains.

Vedic Math helps us by providing some shortcut methods or tricks to perform big calculations. One such trick is done for you.

Squaring of numbers ending with 5.

Example 1: $65 \times 65 = 4225$

Step 1: In 65, the number apart from 5 is 6.

Step 2: Multiply 6 with its next number i.e. 7. So $6 \times 7 = 42$

Step 3: Now multiply the last digits i.e. $5 \times 5 = 25$

Step 4: Write 25 to the right of 42

Step 5: Our answer is 4225.

→ **Find out at least three more tricks using Vedic Math, which will help you to increase the speed and accuracy in your calculations. Now, solve five sums based on each of the three tricks.**

SOCIAL SCIENCE

1. India's President Shri Pranab Mukherjee is due to retire on 25 July 2017. The buzz is already in the air about his possible successor.

The President of the Republic of India is the Head of State of India and the Commander-in-Chief of the Indian Armed Forces.

The President is indirectly elected by the people through elected members of both the houses of the Parliament of India, the Legislative Assemblies of all the states of India and the Legislative Assembly of the Union Territory of Puducherry, as well as, the Legislative Assembly of the National Capital Territory of Delhi and serves for a renewable term of five years. The oath of the President is taken in the presence of the Chief Justice of India, and in his/her absence, by the most senior judge of the Supreme Court of India.

Forests and wildlife are very important for our Earth.

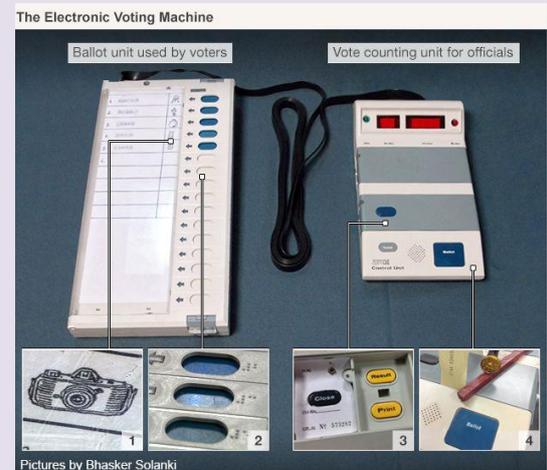


SCIENCE
